

Pray for all our sisters and brothers who are suffering from the effects of wars, separation from families and death. We ask God to shine his light on the families that are suffering during this horrible time.


Prayers for wisdom, peace, harmony, love and kindness to be in the hearts of our leaders on this day as they lead our nation into the future.
