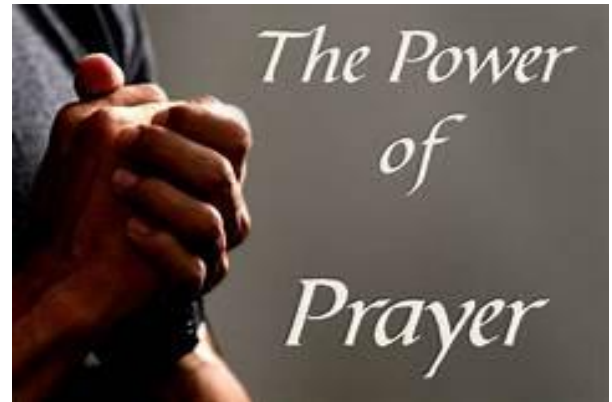

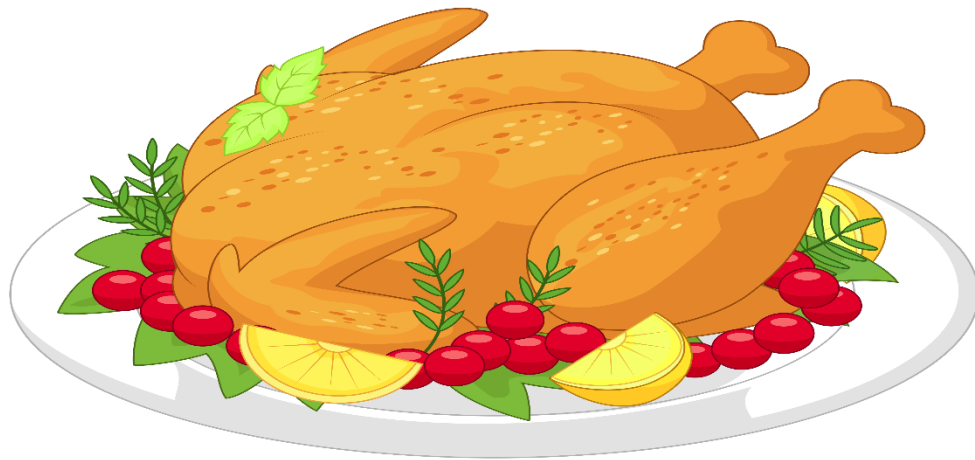


What's Happening at BUMC
